
TERMS & CONDITIONS

These Terms and Conditions apply as between all users of the facilities and Four Feathers Limited (company number 07967015) (trading as Four Feathers Shooting School and referred to below as "FFSS").

SECTION 1 - APPLIES TO ALL USERS OF THE FACILITIES.

1. We take your safety very seriously, and take steps to protect you whilst on the range. However, you must take care of and take responsibility for your personal safety and health (and that of others) while on the range. You recognise that the range has inherent dangers and poses a potential risk to your safety. You accept that risk. You are responsible for ensuring that your behaviour is safe at all times.

2. Suitable safety eye and ear protection must be worn at all times on the range. Suitable safety head protection is strongly advised to be worn at all times on the range. You are responsible for providing your own such equipment. If you elect not to wear ear, eye or head protection (or if the protection you wear is not adequate), you do so at your own risk and FFSS will not be responsible for any injuries you or anyone else sustains as a result.

3. Due to the nature of the range, we would advise that you wear appropriate sturdy footwear.

4. You are responsible for ensuring that you are mentally and physically capable and not prohibited by law from taking part in activities on the range. You confirm that this is the case.

5. You must follow the instructions of FFSS staff at all times.

6. Traps and other pieces of machinery are to be handled only by trained members of FFSS staff. You should not touch the traps or any other machinery.

7. In the event of a trap needing to be refilled or attended to, all firing points must unload. If a call

of 'UNLOAD!' is heard you must stop shooting immediately, guns must be unloaded and any further instructions from FFSS staff followed.

8. You must keep to any marked areas designated on the grounds unless you are with a member of FFSS staff.

9. Please do not drop litter.

10. Guns must only be loaded and closed on the firing point when you are asked to do so by a member of FFSS staff.

11. If you do not hold a shotgun certificate you may only ever be on a firing point if you are accompanied by CWH (Chris Wheatley-Hubbard) according to the Firearms Act 1968, Section 11(5). It is your responsibility to comply with this requirement, and to notify FFSS if you do not hold a shotgun certificate.

12. Guns must be kept unloaded, broken or in slips at all times when behind the firing point. Semi automatic shotguns and pump action shot guns must be shown to be unloaded and have an open breach, and a breach flag should be used where possible.

13. If FFSS staff call a "NO BIRD" on a target, you must not fire a shot at that target. If you are using a second barrel this must be fired only at a full target and not at a piece of broken clay.

14. All guns used on the range must be in proof and in a good and safe working order. It is your responsibility to ensure this.

15. You must use only cartridges that are suitable for your gun, and they must be in good and safe condition. Fibre wads only must be used.

16. Your equipment (including guns and cartridges and safety equipment or safety wear) is your responsibility. FFSS is not responsible for any loss of or damage to your equipment or belongings, or for any loss or damage caused by them.



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17. Notifications of a cancellation must be made by telephone not less than 48hrs before the start time for the booking – after this 50% of the total booking fee will remain payable to FFSS (unless the slot is subsequently filled by a third party and as a result FFSS in its sole discretion decides otherwise).

18. You must not under any circumstances consume any alcohol or use any recreational drugs on the day of your booking, either before or whilst on the range. If FFSS staff believe that this term has been breached, you will be asked to leave the ground and no refund will be payable.

19. We reserve the right to ask you to leave the ground if your behaviour is deemed by FFSS staff to be unsafe, inappropriate or aggressive, or if FFSS staff believe that your participation or presence is unsafe for any reason. No refund will be payable if this occurs.

20. Personal Tuition Sessions may be booked by appointment on days other than Saturdays, at the discretion of FFSS.

21. FFSS shall not under any circumstances be liable to you for (a) any loss or damage to your property, (b) any personal injuries that you sustain as a result of taking part in activities on the range or (c) any indirect or consequential loss arising under or in connection with your use of the range. However, nothing in these terms and conditions limits or excludes the liability of FFSS for death or personal injury caused by its negligence, or the negligence of its staff.

SECTION 2. IN ADDITION TO THE ABOVE TERMS, THE BELOW APPLY TO SIMULATED DAYS.

1. Participants must all hold current shotgun certificates and insurance including shooting cover.

2. Where there are more than six participants, two teams will be created by FFSS staff. Teams are able to load for one another unless a mentor is needed for a novice.

3. Any novices must be declared when booking, as a mentor (provided by FFSS) will be required to stand with them at a charge of £100/half day. If a novice is not declared and their behaviour is deemed unsafe then they may be asked to stop shooting and no refund shall be payable in respect of them, unless a mentor can (at the sole discretion of FFSS) be immediately arranged at the above price.

4. Due to time constraints where two teams are needed then a maximum of five drives are available on full days.

5. ‘Bags’ are dictated by shots fired per person throughout the course of the day.

6. Any catering preferences and allergies must be declared when booking.

7. If participants elect to use their own vehicles this is done at their own risk and any expenses such as fuel consumption will not be covered by FFSS.

8. Anyone using their own vehicle must hold a full driving licence and suitable insurance that covers them for this use. Driving licences and documentary evidence of insurance must be shown to FFSS staff, if asked, at the beginning of the day when drivers are elected.

SECTION 3. ACCEPTANCE.
